Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP-2)

On July 30, 2008, the United States Congress approved Public Law 110-289 – Title III of the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA), 2008, appropriating to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding for emergency assistance for the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed homes and residential properties. HERA was amended and appropriated an additional \$1.93 Billion nationwide for the same purpose. This second round of Neighborhood Stabilization funds, referred to as Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 (NSP2) is available through a competitive process and in order for the Housing Authority of Maricopa County (HAMC) and Scottsdale, Arizona to obtain these funds; the organizations must submit a funding application to HUD no later than July 17, 2009.
